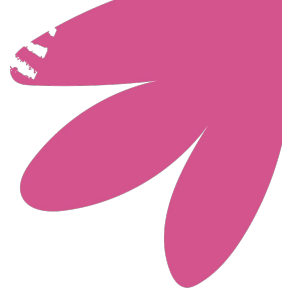
New Campaign

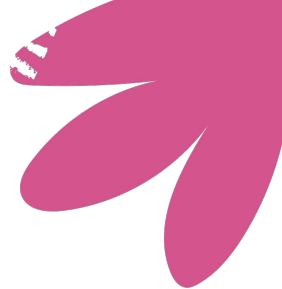
This evolution marks a move away from emotionally heavy storytelling toward an approach that meets people where they are—at a critical moment before a crisis occurs.

Know the Signs 2.0 Campaign



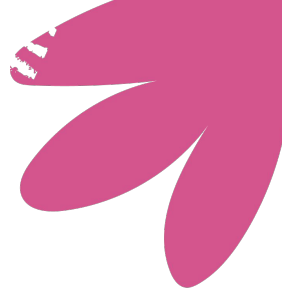
- Educate the public on problem gambling and harm prevention.

Three Themes Within the Campaign



- **The brain science behind gambling**
 - Understanding the psychology behind gambling and breaking down shame and stigma.
- **Sports betting and online gambling awareness**
 - Addressing the rapid growth, visibility, and normalization of online gaming and sports betting.
- **The ripple effect of problem gambling**
 - Exploring how problem gambling impacts families, friends, and communities.



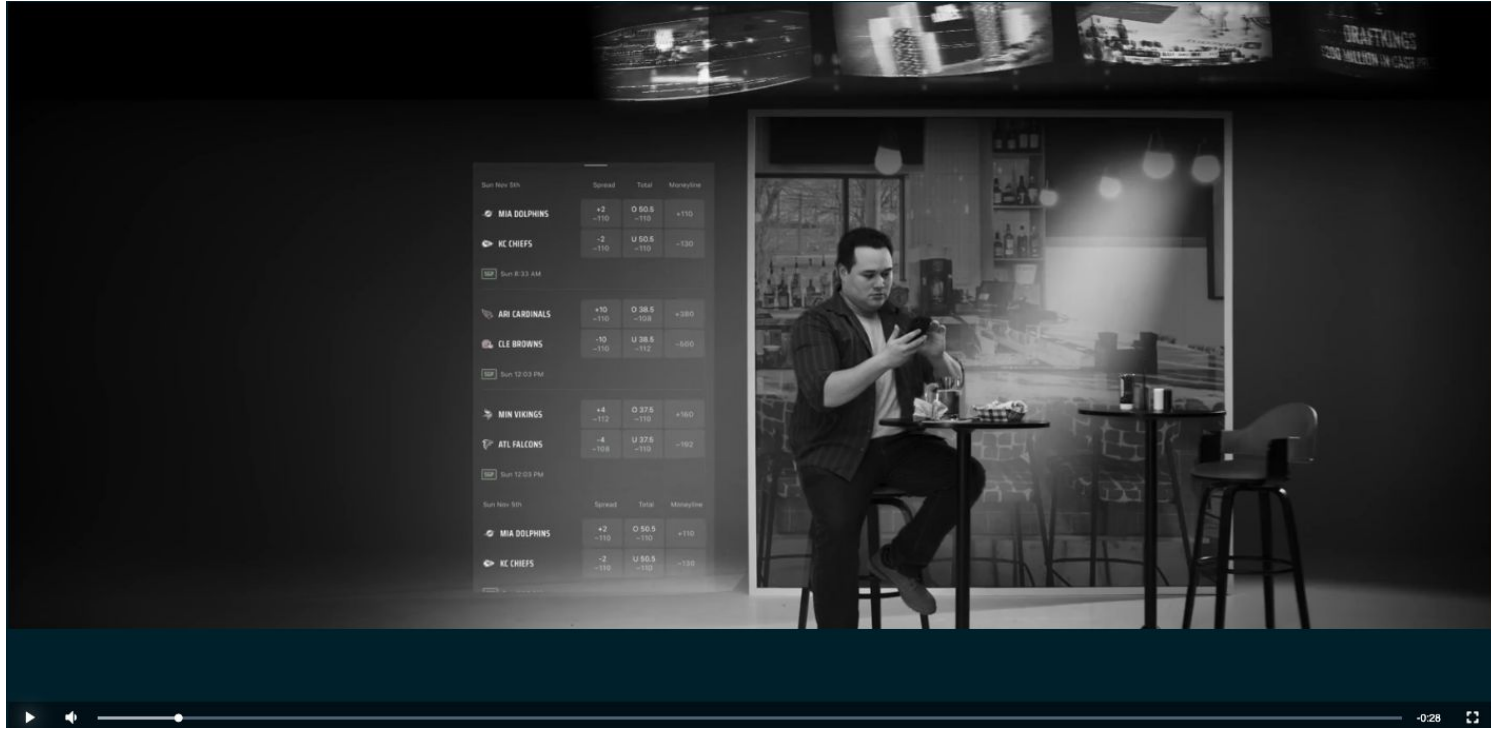

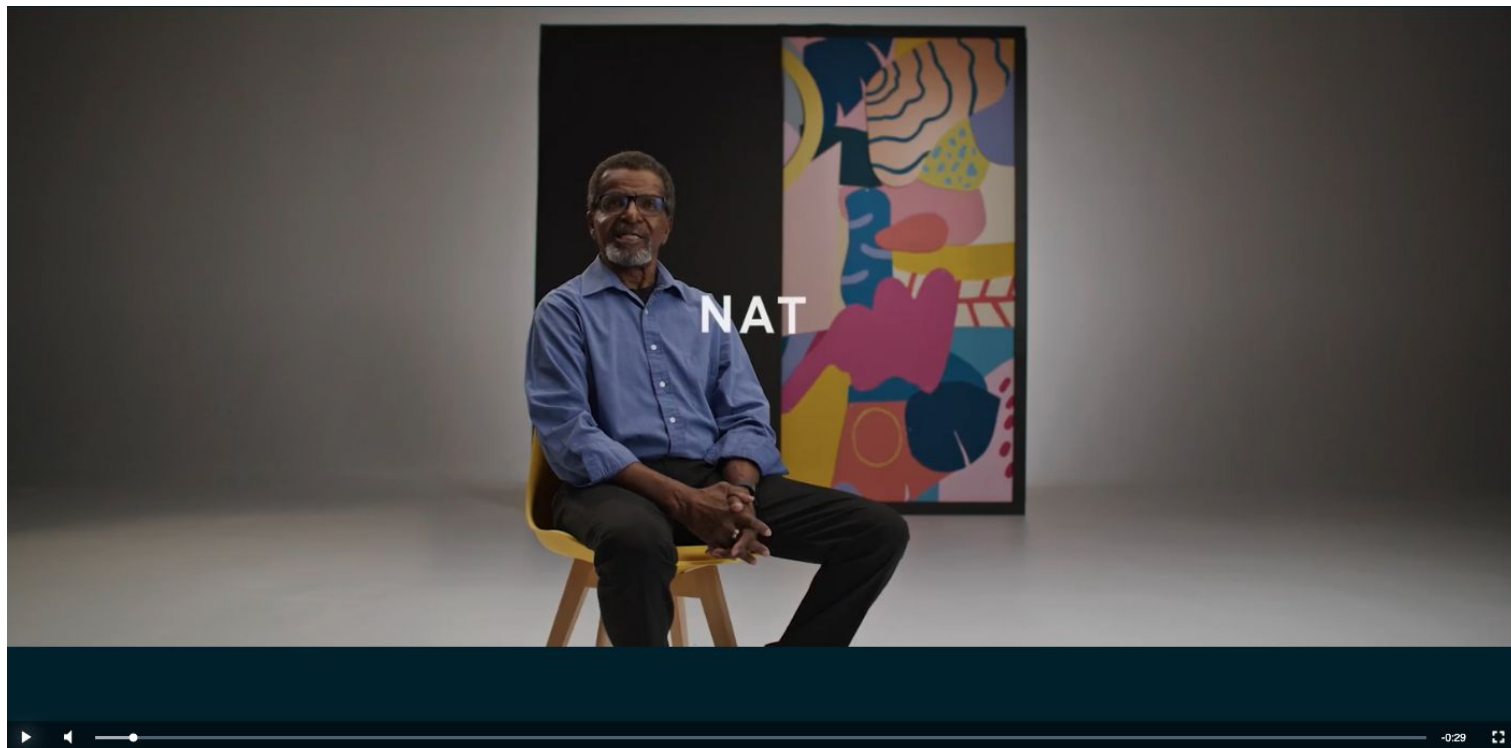

FY26 Social Media

- After reviewing the performance of our organic social media channels over the past year, we noticed that while engagement and follower growth have increased slightly, they haven't expanded at the rate we'd like.
 - We believe this is because the subject matter is deeply personal, and many people may be hesitant to publicly engage with the content.
- Therefore, we decreased KPS3's service budget by \$10K and reallocated those funds to paid advertising hard costs where we can raise awareness. To align our efforts with this adjusted budget, we will no longer be posting on X, however, we will still be posting to Facebook and Instagram.



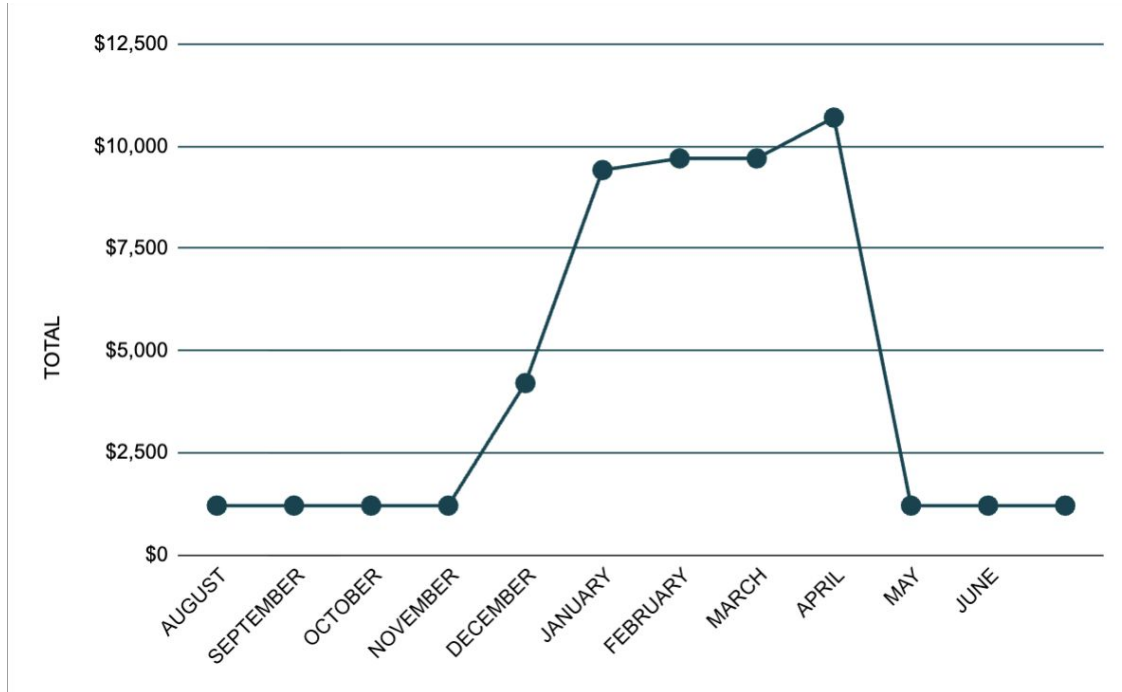

Total FY26 Paid Media Budget \$52,115



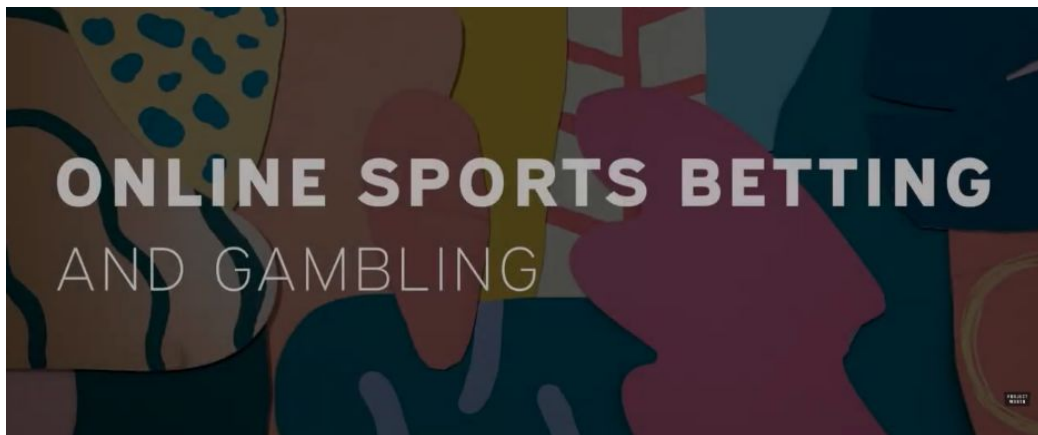
The Big Game Initiative

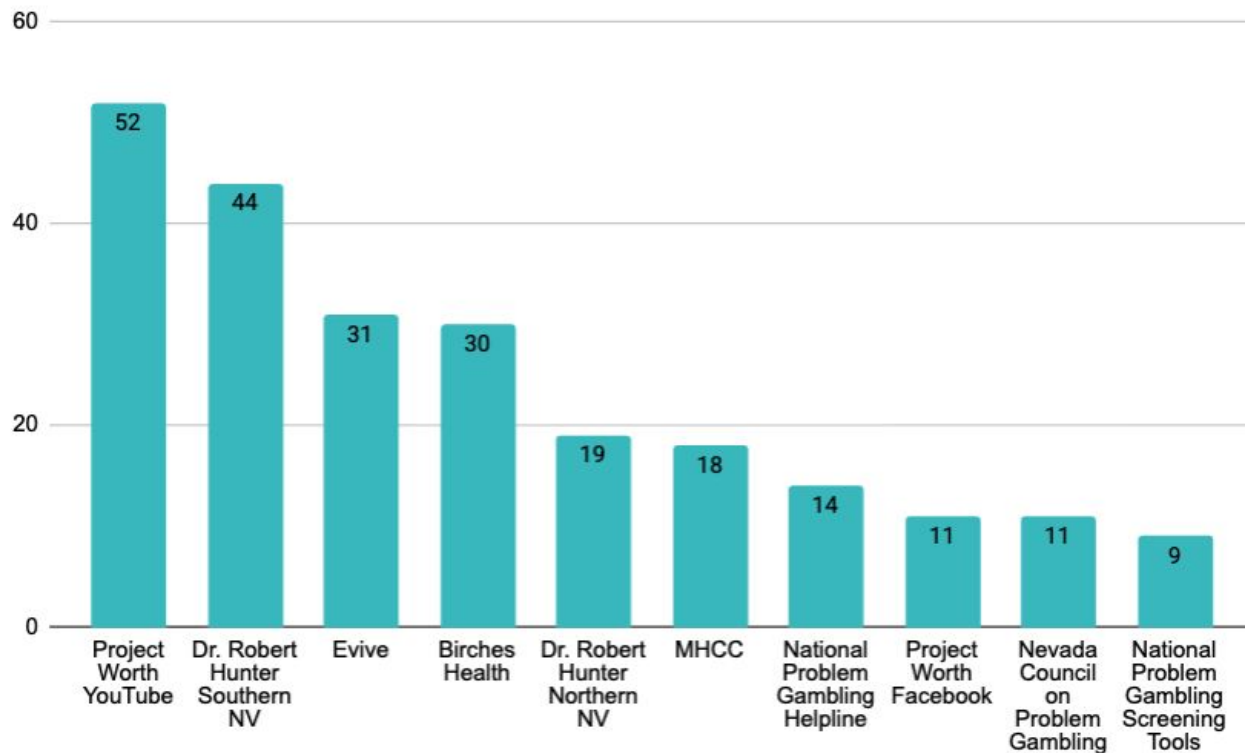
Q2 Website Performance

- Overall website traffic increased significantly by 542%, driven by increased investment in ad placements.
- Quiz engagement also increased, with quiz starts rising by 31% and quiz submissions increasing by 20%.
- Email and phone contacts saw a substantial increase, up 206% compared to the previous period.

The Dr. Robert Hunter International Problem Gambling Center website received a total of 63 clicks, ranking as the most-clicked link on the Project Worth site.

Q2 Paid Search Performance

- Clicks on contact options, such as phone numbers and email links, increased by an impressive 56% this quarter, with gains across both campaigns.
- Paid search recorded a 68% engagement rate (+4.5%) and 995 sessions (+5.2%) during the period.

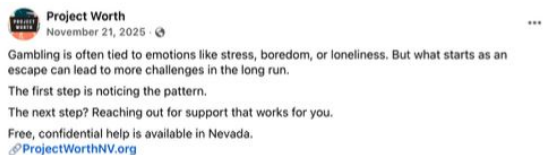

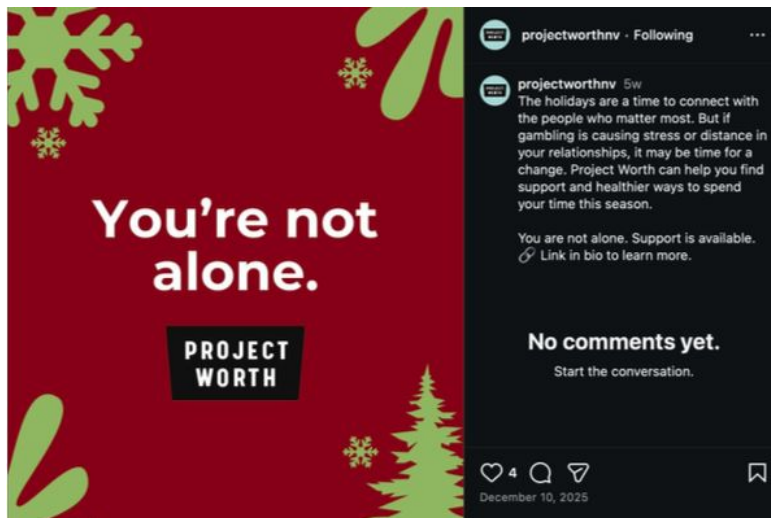
